REGULATION No. 11 .- DUTIES OF MASTE 11. The Master of every vessel, other than a purof any Government, arriving at any port in the wealth, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, we passengers on board for that port, shall, before in entry at the Customs, deliver to an officer a list of all passengers, specifying, to the best of his knowledge, the name, the nationality, the place of shipment, and the calling and occupation of each such passenger.
