

IMMIGRATION RESTRICTION ACT 1901.

REGULATION No. 11.—DUTIES OF MASTER
 11. The Master of every vessel, other than a passenger vessel, of any Government, arriving at any port in the Commonwealth, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, with passengers on board for that port, shall, before entry at the Customs, deliver to an officer a list of all passengers, specifying, to the best of his knowledge, the name, the nationality, the place of shipment, and the calling and occupation of each such passenger.
