## EMIGRANTS' UNDERTAKINGS.

WE whose Names are severally hereunder written, having applied to the Emigration Commissioners, or the Emigration Agent for South Australia for a Passage to that Colony, under the Emigration Regulations, published in the South Australian Government Gazette, of the 7th January, 1858, and we and our respective wives and families (as the case may be) hereunder mentioned, having been approved of for Passages to the said Colony, in a Government Emigrant Vessel, subject to our giving the following undertaking:—Now therefore we, the undersigned, severally hereby promise and agree that if on any pretext whatever, either we, our said wives, or either of our said children (as the case may be) shall quit, or attempt to quit South Australia within the space of two years, from and after the date of our arrival at Port Adelaide, we will severally forfeit and pay to the Commissioner of Crown Lands and Immigration at Adelaide, (or any person duly appointed by him,) on demand, the sum of £10. for ourselves, or wives, or either and every of our said children (as the case may be) so acting; and such penalty shall be summarily recoverable from us in any Court of competent jurisdiction in the said Colony.
