

IMMIGRATION RESTRICTION ACT 1901.

REGULATION 11. The Master of every vessel of any Government, arriving at any port, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, passengers on board for that port, entry at the Customs, deliver to an officer passengers, specifying, to the best of name, the nationality, the place of calling and occupation of each such passenger.
