The Master of every vessel, other than a public vessel of any Government, arriving at any port in the Commonwealth, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, with any passengers on board, shall, before that port, deliver to an officer a list of all such passengers, specifying, to the best of his knowledge, the name, the nationality, the place of shipment, and the calling and occupation of each such passenger.
