12. (1) The Master of a vessel, other than a public vessel of a Government, arriving at any port in the Commonwealth, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, with any passengers on board for that port, shall, before making entry at the Customs, deliver to an officer a list of all the passengers for that port, specifying, to the best of his knowledge, the name, nationality, race, place of shipment, and calling or occupation of each of those passengers. (2) The Master and the Medical Officer (if any) of the vessel shall make and sign a statement in writing on the list stating, to the best of his knowledge or belief, as to each of the passengers, whether he or she is an idiot, or is insane or mentally defective, or is suffering from consumption or tuberculosis in any form, or is suffering from any infectious or contagious disease of a loathsome or dangerous character, or is subject to any physical disability or infirmity likely to cause him or her to become a charge upon the public or any charitable institution. (3) The Medical Officer of a vessel who refuses or neglects to make and sign the statement required by this section, or who makes or signs any statement under this section which is incorrect in any material particular, shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations.

(2) The Master and the Medical Officer (if any) of the vessel shall make and sign a statement in writing on the list stating, to the best of his knowledge or belief, as to each of the passengers, whether he or she is an idiot, or is insane or mentally defective, or is suffering from consumption or tuberculosis in any form, or is suffering from any infectious or contagious disease of a loathsome or dangerous character, or is subject to any physical disability or infirmity likely to cause him or her to become a charge upon the public or any charitable institution.  
(3) The Medical Officer of a vessel who refuses or neglects to make and sign the statement required by this section, or who makes or signs any statement under this section which is incorrect in any material particular, shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations.
