"Pak Wan" Via Brindisi  
I am directed to inform you

that  
George Collinson, age 22. Plumber, English. Lt  
Arrived. Math<sup>w</sup>. Johnson " 24 " " Lt  
29 Aug 74 embarked in the ship Martha Birnie, Capt.  
Samson, on the 16<sup>th</sup> ult. from London, under  
the United Kingdom Assisted Regulations. They  
occupied one of the Cabins of the ship.

Enclosed is a list of 26 souls  
equal to 23 1/2 statute adults who embarked  
in the ship "Pak Wan" 795 tons register,  
Capt. Lawrence, from the same Port on the  
30<sup>th</sup> ult. The emigrants are most  
comfortably quartered between decks,  
and the vessel would have carried a Surgeon  
but up to the last moment of her sailing  
Capt. Lawrence found it impossible to  
procure one
