REGULATION No. 11.—Duties of Masters.

of any Government, arriving at any port in the Common-wealth, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, with any passengers on board for that port, shall, before making entry at the Customs, deliver to an officer a list of all such passengers, specifying, to the best of his knowledge, the name, the nationality, the place of shipment, and the calling and occupation of each such passenger.
