The West Terrace Cemetery was the contractor for the burial of destitute persons and the register comprises forms, certificates and notes from the Destitute Board, Adelaide Children's Hospital, Adelaide Hospital, the police, the Lying-In Home or the Coroner stating that the deceased person did not have known relatives, or their relatives were unable to afford Cemetery fees.
