our most sincere and heartfelt thanks to
Doctor Hill and Captain Manning for their
unwearied, kind, humane, and obliging attention,
which they have rendered on all occasions
during our voyage from England, and which
we have under God's blessing so happily and
prosperously ended.

That we consider ourselves
especially blessed, and our utter incapability
to return thanks to the "Great Disposer" of all
events for the great mercies which He hath
safely vouchsafed unto us during our long and perilous
passage (and singularly as it may appear)
we nevertheless have no hesitation in asserting
that not one isolated case of an infection, or
of a serious nature of illness occurred out of
227 souls, which we in our opinion consider
it justly due, and mainly to be attributed to
the admirable arrangements made by Doctor
Hill, and with his "characteristic" kindness ably
assisted by Captain Manning, in promoting
the health, comfort, and ease of those subjected
to their care; we also feel it our pleasing
duty to return our united thanks to the
Officers, and Crew, for their civil, and
Courteous

courteous bearing.

O Lord we can do in return
for the kindness and consideration which
we have so freely attempted to describe, is
to offer up our prayers to the "Throne of Grace",
and to teach our little ones to bless their
names, that they may join us in beseeching
Him who sitteth thereon, to bless and prosper
all their undertakings, and finally after this
life they may obtain everlasting joy and
glorification.

In the most sincere and fervent
