13th. GENERAL REMARKS
AND SUGGESTIONS,
IF ANY.

From Dec 9th until Dec 30th the
thermometer stood very high -
averaging 80° in the shade.
During this period there was a great deal
of sickness. Two patients were admitted
into the Hospital suffering from Cerebral
Congestion, one child from convulsions, and
one woman Ellen Nolan from mania.

Two patients were admitted into the Hospital
suffering from simple continued fever.
And at the same time a great many people
suffered from excessive debility.

The principal disease during the voyage
has been diarrhoea. People of all ages were
attacked - but a large number of the
children suffered severely from this complaint.
There were several cases of jaundice among
the children.

The regulations were well observed on board
and my instructions for the order and cleanliness
of the ship were well carried out.

At the musters the people always presented
a clean and tidy appearance.

The school on board was well attended, and
the children made great progress.

About 20 young men made great improvement
under the schoolmaster's instruction.
