IMMIGRATION RESTRICTION ACTS 1901-1905.

REGULATION No. 11.—Duties of Masters.

11. The Master of every vessel, other than a public vessel of any Government, as riving at any port in the Commonwealth, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, with any passengers on board for that port, shall, before making entry at the Customs, deliver to an officer a list of all such passengers, specifying, to the best of his knowledge, the name, the nationality and race, the place of shipment, and the calling and occupation of each such passenger; and he shall, if required by the officer, certify in writing that to the best of his knowledge and belief none of the passengers in the list (except as therein stated) is an idiot or insane person, or a person suffering from an infectious or contagious disease of a loathsome or dangerous character, or a person likely by reason of any physical disability to become a charge upon the public or upon any public or charitable institution.
